

## FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off Voting Competition – Terms and Conditions

1. Voting opens on Wednesday 28 May 2025 and closes at 5pm on Saturday 5 July 2025.
2. Each person can vote only once, per email address.
3. Votes will only be accepted from NZ IP addresses and not by any other means, such as postal mail, email, phone, social media etc.
4. FMG takes no responsibility for any votes which are not submitted in accordance with these Terms & Conditions.
5. FMG reserves the right to disqualify a team if evidence is discovered that:
  - a. any of the votes submitted for that team have been dishonestly procured, generated, or submitted; or
  - b. improper vote sourcing methods have been used; or
  - c. votes were otherwise in breach of these Terms & Conditions; or
  - d. FMG in its sole discretion, considers to be inappropriate or contrary to the spirit of FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off.
6. FMG reserves the right to check votes in any way it deems appropriate, including, but not limited to, checking accounts by IP address, city, and email address.
7. Voting for FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off is deemed acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.
8. When you visit the FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off voting site, you may do so anonymously. FMG will not collect your name, email address or other information unless you choose to provide it to us by voting for FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off.
9. If you vote for an FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off, FMG will collect personal information about you, including your email address and region. FMG will use such information for vote-checking and analytics purposes related to this competition.
10. FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off voting is securely hosted, and all information is protected against unauthorised access.
11. You have the right to access and correct the information that FMG holds about you. If you believe the information is incorrect, you may ask that it be corrected by contacting us on 0800 366 466.
12. Every person who votes online goes in the draw to win a \$500 Bonfire card (the Prize). The draw will take place on Thursday 10 July 2025 at FMG Head Office in Wellington and the winner will be notified by Friday 18 July 2025 by email address entered during voting. The Prize will be couriered to the winner. Only one winner will be drawn.
13. The winning region of the FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off will be the region that earns the largest number of points. If two or more regions receive an equal number of votes, the winning region will be then drawn by FMG.
14. The winning region of the FMG Young Farmer of the Year Region-off award will receive a \$5,000 towards their selected regional cause/charity. Additionally, \$1,000 will be awarded to the senior team of the winning region. \$1,000 will be awarded to the junior teams of the winning region. \$1,000 will be awarded to the Agrikids teams of the winning region.
